Thank you for your ongoing support of our focus on attendance this year, as we head into term 2.

The national data for attendance suggests that Winterstoke Hundred is likely to be in the top 5% of state schools in the country on this measure, and we are very pleased our students are taking this seriously. The research shows that this will correlate into your child's academic progress.

In our reports last year, we released percentile rank data for your child that shows their attendance relative to the rest of their Year Group.

Our aim is to release this data termly, for your information, and you should receive this email for your child in the near future.
