It is exciting to start the journey of Post 16 study. Some aspects of this will be a step up from GCSE. Students are expected to complete 5 hours of independant study per subject per week. Most of this can be achieved in the study time between lessons. Some of this will be set by their teacher on Classcharts and some will be revision and development of their notes from class.

Parents can access Classcharts via a code that we will send home with students, and email to the first contact on the contact list.



Expectations and the School Day

We have 3 rules at Winterstoke Hundred Academy **Be Safe, Be Kind and Work Hard.**

We aspire to create a culture that means during your child's time with us, they will develop work habits and traits that will see them through a successful future, such as punctuality, politeness and resilience.

We understand that post 16 students will often have part time work, in order that it doesn't affect their studies we recommend it is 8 hours or less per week, and that if they work shifts that they don't start until 5pm or later as they may have revision or other classes to attend in P7.
